

GENERAL SCHOOL CONDUCT

Student Right

Students have the right to move about the school and take advantage of instructional and related activities in an atmosphere where students can learn and teachers can teach.

Student Responsibility

Students have the responsibility to abide by all reasonable district, building, and classroom rules established by school officials. Students shall practice common rules of courtesy that are necessary in group settings to avoid disruption in the school and to protect school property and the health, safety, and welfare of students and teachers.

School Policy/Regulation

School officials shall inform all students concerning the provisions of this code annually.

Study Hall is a class: students are expected to have materials to study.

Range of Consequences

Students violating this section shall be subject to action as determined by the school or teachers, which may include:

- Verbal reprimand
- Parental notification
- Referral to administration
- Suspension of privileges
- Detention
- Suspension
- Expulsion
