

LEAVING THE BUILDING OR GROUNDS WITHOUT PERMISSION

Student Right

Students have the right not to be exposed to the dangers involved in leaving the school premises without permission.

Student Responsibility

In regard to student attendance, students have the responsibility for following the procedures outlined for Williams Bay Junior and Senior High School Students.

School Policy/Regulation

Wisconsin Statutes 121-02(1) provide that schools schedule at least 1137 hours of direct pupil instruction annually.

Students absent from class without authorization are considered truant.

School Board Policy 431, 431 Rule

Action

If a student cuts a class*, but does not leave the school grounds, their first offense will bring a detention. Subsequent offenses will be dealt with using in-school and out-of-school suspensions of appropriate duration.

If a student cuts a class or classes, and leaves the school grounds, they will receive a suspension of appropriate duration.

**Cutting a class means that a student, after reporting for school, fails to report for a significant portion of a class on that day.*
