Dear Parents,

We hope this school year is off to a wonderful start! It has been so nice to see the kids back in school and to resume our work with students. During the school day, each grade level will have 30 minutes that is called What I Need Now (WINN) time. During the WINN block, students participate in enrichment activities or receive extra support in reading, math or language skills. This way of scheduling ensures that no student is missing core math or reading instruction to receive extra support.

After reviewing assessment and classroom data, some students are selected for extra math and reading support with Ms. Connley (reading) and/or Mrs. Stephens (math) during WINN time. In Ms. Connley's reading groups, students learn early reading skills, word attack strategies, spelling patterns, comprehension skills and practice reading fluency. Mrs. Stephens' groups will focus on building strategies for solving multi-step problems and working on basic addition, subtraction, multiplication and/or division facts. Both teachers work with small groups of students, outside the classroom for 30 minutes, 2-3 days a week.
