I. CALL TO ORDER

President J. Lothian called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

- II. ACTION ITEMS
  - A. Discuss & Approve 2020-2021 School Calendar Modification

Dr. White shared that the administrative team was recommending changing the 2020-2021 school year calendar to make Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> a professional development day for recalibration of the reopening of schools plan. Prior to this day, families would be surveyed families on how in-person and distance learning is to allow them to share with us what is working and not working. On October 2<sup>nd</sup>, teachers will take this information and collaborate on potential adjustments that need to be made to enhance the learning experience the district is providing, including time to individually connect with Distance Learning students as needed.

K. Nelson/D. Woss motion and second to approve changing the 2020-2021 school year calendar, making Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> a professional development day for teachers and a non-school day for students. Motion carried 5 – 0.

B. Discuss & Approve Revision of Reopening Plan

Dr. White presented the Williams Bay School District COVID-19 plan. He shared that Governor Ever's Executive Order requiring face covering is set to expire on September 28<sup>th</sup>. The administrative team is recommending that all district employees and all students five years of age or older, wear a face covering and maintain social distancing to the fullest extent possible while in the school building. The district would continue with the face covering guidelines that are currently in place. The board asked questions about how the students and staff are responding to the face covering requirement and other guidelines. Dr. White shared that everyone had adjusted to the guidelines and things were going well. Dr. Peyer/D. Woss motion and second to approve the revised Williams Bay School District Reopening Plan as presented, carried 5 - 0.
