Carried 5-0.

V. Discussion Items

A. Discuss Opening of School for the 2021-2022 School Year

Dr. White developed the district's reopening plan taking into consideration guidelines for the CDC, the State of Wisconsin as well as surrounding districts. He developed a draft then shared with district staff to get feedback. The goal of the plan is to start school as close to normal as possible, making masks optional and not requiring vaccines. The district will provide testing, but it will not be required and the district will follow county guidelines as far as quarantining and contact tracing. The draft plan will be sent out to parents tomorrow and a listening session is scheduled for August 3rd at 6:00 p.m. After the listening session, the plan will be revised as needed and Dr. White will bring the final plan to the board for approval.

- J. Lothian asked if the administration had concerns regarding self policing by family regarding symptoms. His concern is most around those that show symptoms, are sent home and keep coming back. Dr. White said that administration will work closely with the school nurse and if symptoms are still present, they will be sent home again. Discussion followed.
- E. Nichols expressed his concern regarding the elementary age kids that are not eligible for the vaccine. For them, nothing has changed for them since last year. Dr. White said that the district is concerned about our kids and wants to ensure we are taking care of them, including emotionally and academically.
- P. Peyer inquired about monitoring and reporting cases on the website again this year. The board felt that having the dashboard active and updated regularly was important.

B. Updates on Maintenance Projects

Dr. White presented updates regarding the summer maintenance projects. The sidewalk outside of the middle/high school is completed. The tuckpointing has progressed and should be completed in a week or so. The windows on the west side of the middle/high school have been installed. The windowsills are on order. The doors at the end of the high school wing are scheduled to be installed next

week and the painting for the outdoor overhangs and middle/high school library should start the first week in August.

VI. Public Comments

Heidi Stocking - thanked the board for letting the kids to be kids when school starts. She also asked the board to consider doing zoom for all school board meetings for people to be able to participate if they are sick or out of town.
