

132 BOARD MEMBER RESIGNATION

The Board believes that any citizen who files for and seeks election to the Board should do so with full knowledge of and appreciation for the investment in time, effort, and dedication expected of all Board members, and such action should reflect his or her intention to serve a full term of office.

However, if for health, changes in domicile or any other compelling reason a member does decide to terminate service, the Board requests the earliest possible notification of intent to resign so that the Board may plan appropriately for this exigency. A letter of resignation must be submitted to the School Board before any formal action can be taken.
