

150 SCHOOL BOARD POWERS AND DUTIES

The Williams Bay School Board will act as the general agent of the State of Wisconsin in representing the people of the district in matters of public-school business.

The Board shall perform all duties prescribed by law and shall exercise any and all powers prescribed by Wisconsin Statutes.

In addition, the Board may do all things reasonable to promote the course of education, including establishing, providing, and improving district programs, functions, and activities for the benefit of students.
