331 EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

Evaluation of the effectiveness of the school program is one of the primary responsibilities of the School Board. The District Administrator and/or building Principals shall be responsible for reporting program progress periodically to the Board.

Program evaluation shall be established and maintained and may include the following elements.

- 1. National and state standardized general achievement tests, and specific standardized tests in academic subjects.
- 2. Individual achievement and diagnostic tests.
- 3. School achievement records.
- 4. Graduate follow-up studies.
- 5. Teacher and parent evaluations.
