

## 443.5 ELECTRONIC DEVICES

The School Board believes that student use and possession of personal electronic devices for educational use is beneficial to learning and is therefore encouraged. The building principal will develop rules and guidelines that are printed in the Parent/Student Handbooks to regulate the possession and use of cellular telephones or personal electronic devices during the school day, on school premises, and at school-sponsored activities. Use of personal electronic devices may also be restricted and regulated at the discretion of the supervising teacher, coach, or bus driver. The building principal or his/her designee may modify the regulations if the student provides evidence that such a device is required for medical, school, educational, vocational, or other legitimate use.

Students who bring any of the above-listed devices to school do so at their own risk and must store the equipment in their locker during the school day. Also, students shall not use any DEVICE in any restroom or locker room while at school or while at a school-sponsored activity. The Williams Bay School District shall not be responsible for the safety or security of personal electronic equipment that students choose to bring to school.

Students are prohibited from possessing or bringing laser pointers onto school premises at all times.

Whether by digital, electronic, or other means, no student shall create, obtain or capture any image of another student(s) or staff member whether at school or under the supervision of a school authority, without prior authorization of school officials. It is considered a violation of this policy to send, distribute, post, or transmit such image(s) to or by use of the Internet, to or by use of a social networking site, or any other location that can be accessed or used by the public.

Students who violate this policy shall be subject to disciplinary action following established procedures.
