448 STUDENTS OF LEGAL AGE

Students reaching the age of majority (eighteen years of age) shall be subject to all school rules as other students are and will be responsible for all their actions while at school and school functions including co-curricular activities.

A student of legal age may:

- 1. Exercise his/her right to control access to his/her student records following board policy and state and federal laws;
- 2. Sign absence excuses and permission slips himself/herself; and
- 3. Discontinue or forgo school-parent notification procedures.
