453 STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

A primary concern of the Williams Bay School Board is that proper attention is paid to the safety of students. The Board and administration shall try to prevent accidents by creating a safe school environment and shall standardize procedures for handling emergencies.

The District shall provide for the following emergency care services:

Annual Safety Review for Teachers

- As part of the pre-school workshop, a presentation about teacher responsibility regarding emergency care shall be scheduled.
- Teachers shall be provided with a list of students who have special health problems that could require emergency care. Special care information should be obtained by the parents or guardian in cooperation with their family doctor.

Training for Those Personnel Designated to be Responsible for Emergency Care

- One or more employees in each building shall be designated as emergency care persons.
- Emergency care individuals should hold a valid First-Aid Certificate, CPR Certificate, and AED Certificate. The Standard First Aid or Multi-Media First Aid Certificate is an accepted standard.
- Training of individuals responsible for emergency care may be provided by the American Red Cross.

Emergency Nursing Services

- Emergency nursing services shall be provided under the direction of a nurse (s) registered in Wisconsin.
- Arrangements shall be made with a physician to serve as medical advisor for the emergency nursing service.
- Procedures for dealing with accidental injury, illness, and medication at all school-sponsored activities and methods of recording services provided shall be developed.
- An emergency care person shall be available during the regular school day including curricular and co-curricular activities of students.
- Student emergency information cards, equipment and supplies, and space for the emergency nursing services shall be readily accessible.

• The school nurse shall make an annual review of the nursing services.
