

522 STAFF CONDUCT

The Williams Bay School District expects its employees to do quality work, maintain confidentiality, work efficiently, and exhibit a professional, courteous and respectful attitude toward other employees, parents, and students.

The District also expects employees to:

1. Comply with all applicable work rules, job descriptions, terms of the Employee Handbook and legal obligations; and
2. Comply with the standards of conduct set out in Board policies, the Employee Handbook, and any other policies, regulations, and guidelines that impose duties, requirements, or standards attendant to their status as District employees.

Violation of any policies, rules, regulations, and guidelines may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination. Disciplinary actions shall be carried out following established District procedures.

Some infractions have implications beyond the employment relationship between the District and an individual employee, and the District may inform local, state, and federal officials of such conduct. Included among the behaviors covered by this policy are violations of applicable law, “immoral conduct” that could result in revocation of an individual’s licensure through the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, and any other actions that the District deems pertinent.
