720 SAFETY PROGRAM

Every reasonable precaution shall be taken for the safety of students, employees, visitors and others having business with the district. The School Board believes that safety education and accident prevention are important to everyone concerned with the Williams Bay School District.

The District Administrator is delegated the responsibility of developing and executing the safety and healthful facility program and shall serve as safety and facility coordinator. Building principals shall be safety and facility supervisors. The program shall meet the codes and regulations of the State of Wisconsin, including those of the Department of Commerce and Department of Public Instruction.

A school safety plan shall be developed and in effect in each District school to provide as safe an environment as possible for students, employees, and citizens while they are present on school premises or participating in school-sponsored activities.
