

723 EMERGENCY PLANS

The Board recognizes its responsibility to provide facilities, equipment and training that may minimize the effects of disasters. It is the responsibility of the district to develop a school disaster plan that will provide as much protection as possible for students, employees, and others while at school and for students on their way to and from school. It is also the responsibility of the district to provide adequate instruction so that the school emergency plan may be carried out with the greatest possible speed and safety.

The District Administrator shall be directed to develop emergency plans for evacuating the buildings during fire, or as otherwise necessary, as well as plans for using the buildings for shelter in the safest manner possible during extremely inclement weather or other emergencies.

Drills shall be held to implement such plans to allow for order and efficiency in the event of a true emergency.
