## 723.2 BOMB THREATS

Being responsible for the safety of a large number of students, teachers and other staff personnel, it is incumbent upon school administrators to do all that is prudent and possible in the event of imminent danger.

In the event of the interruption of the normal operation of the school because of an emergency created by some threat to the safety of the school and its inhabitants, the District Administrator, or in his/her absence the Building Principal, shall make an immediate decision for safeguarding the welfare of the school's population.

Evacuation procedures shall be developed by the District Administrator and Building Principals.

Any student found guilty of turning in a bomb threat shall be disciplined according to established procedures.
