#### GOALS

During the 2023-2024 school year, every classroom/grade level at WBES will participate in at least 4 community engagement activities/partnerships (68 total) and record events on a <u>shared</u> document.

By May 2024, 80% of WBES tudents in 4K-5th grade will meet their individual math skill focus using quarterly classroom assessment data. During the 2023-2024 school year, all students will learn about character education and work to demonstrate good character traits throughout the year. Teachers will identify 3 students each month who demonstrate that character trait.

GOALS	ACTION STEPS
GOAL 1: During the 2023-2024 school year, every classroom/grade level at WBES will participate in at least 4 community engagement activities/partnerships (68 total) and record events on a <u>shared document</u> .	<ul> <li>Provide resources for teachers to use to determine which community activities align with their classroom, grade level, or specialty</li> <li>Staff will have time to collaborate for community activity planning</li> <li>Focus on building strong community partnerships while practicing expectations and manners in the community</li> <li>Use teachable moments and authentic experiences to provide a sense of belonging and acceptance to help encourage demonstrating respect in and with the community</li> <li>Use the components of the classroom learning community to build ownership, responsibility, accountability, and participation in the community</li> <li>Keep record of community activity and experiences on the <u>shared</u> <u>document</u> provided.</li> </ul>
GOAL 2: By May 2024, 80% of WBES students in 4K-5th grade will meet their grade level math skill focus using monthly classroom assessment data.	<ul> <li>Educate staff on analyzing various data to determine specific areas of need for individual students</li> <li>Collaborate with appropriate staff to provide resources to meet the needs of all students</li> <li>Collaborate with grade level teachers, interventionist, and special education teachers to build individual capacity in order to provide instruction that meet the needs of all students</li> <li>Provide specific math interventions during WINN time and within classroom timeframe based on multiple forms of data, formal , and informal assessments</li> <li>Promote math and how it is used as a daily part of life</li> <li>Record data each month and report it to building principal</li> </ul>
GOAL 3: During the 2023-2024 school year, all students will learn about character education and work to demonstrate good character traits throughout the year. Teachers will identify 3 students each month who demonstrate that character trait.	<ul> <li>Provide daily character education trait information during announcements</li> <li>Teachers will reinforce the character trait information with students in class</li> <li>Students will be encouraged to demonstrate character traits</li> <li>Consistently provide stamps to students who demonstrate character traits at school.</li> <li>Identify and report to the principal 3 students per classroom and 1 student per essentials who demonstrate the monthly character trait.</li> <li>Students who are identified as demonstrating the monthly character trait will receive a certificate and a pencil. A "Paw" will be placed on the bulletin board.</li> </ul>
