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Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s) of 10th Graders:

The Williams Bay School District believes that the family plays a crucial role in students' human growth and development. The schools support both parent/guardians and children in their efforts to develop an understanding of human sexuality and family. We recognize that the topic of human growth and development is a very sensitive and important area of your child's education and we do not intend for this course to replace the parents' vital role in teaching and guiding their children. Our primary objective is to give students reliable information and to enhance and strengthen the communication bond between you and your child. Throughout our instruction we will encourage students to seek further information from you.

The Human Growth and Development unit will be taught again this year to tenth graders as part of their health curriculum. Some will begin their study in the fall, the rest will be taught during the second semester. The tenth-grade curriculum is entitled Health 10 and includes units in Etiquette and Manners, Understanding Human Sexuality: Making Healthy Choices and First Aid. The health class will be taught three days a week for approximately a semester. Ms. Racky and Mr. Breen will be the instructors.
